SPECIFICATIONS FOR HDPE MILK POUCH CRATES (10 Ltrs.)

The crates shall be made of FOOD GRADE HDPE (Raw material: Grade-M60075 / L60075 of M/s. RIL) and shall be suitable to hold 20 nos of 500 ml. Milk Satchets (**for 10 Ltrs Crates**). Weight per 10 Ltrs Crate should be **1200 gms + 2%**. Crates of lesser weight will not be accepted.

(1) Approximate dimensions of 10 Ltrs crates shall be as under :-

i) Outer length at the top	560 mm to 570 mm
ii) Inner length at the top	525 mm to 535 mm
iii) Outer breadth at the top	290 mm to 300 mm
iv) Inner breadth at the top	225 mm to 235 mm
v) Outer length at the bottom	515 mm to 525 mm
vi) Inner length at the bottom	510 mm to 520 mm
vii) Outer breadth at the bottom	200 mm to 205 mm
viii) Inner breadth at the bottom	190 mm to 195 mm
ix) Outer height	175 mm to 180 mm
x) Inner height	170 mm to 175 mm
xi) Stacking rib height	60 mm + 1mm

The design of the crates shall be such that it should be possible to stack empty crates one into another and so on while the crates filled with milk sachets should sit one over another without damaging the sachets. It should also match with our existing crates.

i) **Normally about 11 crates** would be stacked one above another when filled with milk sachets and as such it is very essential that the crates and their side walls are strong enough to withstand vertical load of about **120 kg.** or so.

ii). Grooves (elevations/ depressions) provided in the crates for reinforcement should project outside to increase the inner space.

iii) Bottom portion of the crates shall be flat & sufficiently strong to withstand the load, **without any studs.**

iv) Words "**Banglar Dairy**" shall be printed on both sides (lengthwise) of the crates with white/blue or any other colour. Suitable gripping facilities shall also be provided for easy handling of the crates.

v) Once a particular design is finalised and accepted, no change in design whatsoever in nature shall be done without having prior written consent of "**Banglar Dairy**" and consistency in supply shall be maintained.

vi) Crates shall be supplied in **Yellow Colour** (Colours of Crate may change, if required by our competent authority). Colour requirement shall be indicated in the particular purchase orders. Each Consignment should be accompanied by a certificate stating the following, with specific mention of manufacturer of raw material, grade no (s), etc :-

(a) **that the consignment has been made from Food Grade Raw material only,**

(b) that the Pigment used for the consignment is Non-Toxic and safe for the milk to be carried in the Crates. Month and year of manufacture shall be engraved on one of the sides of the rim or at the bottom of the crates along with code of the manufacturer.
